Impact in Sandoval:

Bernalillo Public Schools is a natural fit for Mission: Graduate's attendance team program.

Bernalillo has employed several strategies to improve student attendance including: Attendance Mentors and a "What's your Role" campaign, which encourages the entire community to support good student attendance. Mission: Graduate also provides support in analyzing chronic absence data.

United Way of Central New Mexico is committed to investing in our communities. During the shutdown caused by COVID-19, we invested an additional \$67,100 in Sandoval County.
