## Impact in Valencia:

UWCNM's education initiative, Mission: Graduate, works with the Valencia County Partnership for a Work Ready Community to provide career exploration experiences that can help students learn the knowledge, skills, and attitudes needed for success in the workplace. Through career days, employer presentations, and other activities, students also learn about the vast number of career opportunities available in Valencia County. In the 2019/2020 school year, over 2,000 students participated in some type of career exploration activity with 38 employer partners in nine events. In the July 2020 virtual Summer Teacher Academy, 37 teachers and employers participated in employer and educator workshops that discussed the education, skills, and attitudes needed for success in the workplace. Tips and tools for virtual teaching were also presented. These activities help teachers to help students make the connection between classroom lessons and real-world work applications.

United Way of Central New Mexico is committed to investing in our communities. During the shutdown caused by COVID-19, we invested \$30,000 in Valencia County. We awarded \$8,000 through the Emergency Action Fund (in collaboration with the Albuquerque Community Foundation) and \$22,000 through the Feeding Families Fund: United We Eat. In addition, UWCNM awarded \$57,200 through the Community Investment process.
