Calls are answered 7 days a week, 8 a.m. to midnight, 365 days a year.



The Family Advocacy Center is many different agencies all working together under one roof. The facility, located downtown, offers support services such as medical care, advocacy, legal and financial assistance, as well as law enforcement and prosecution.

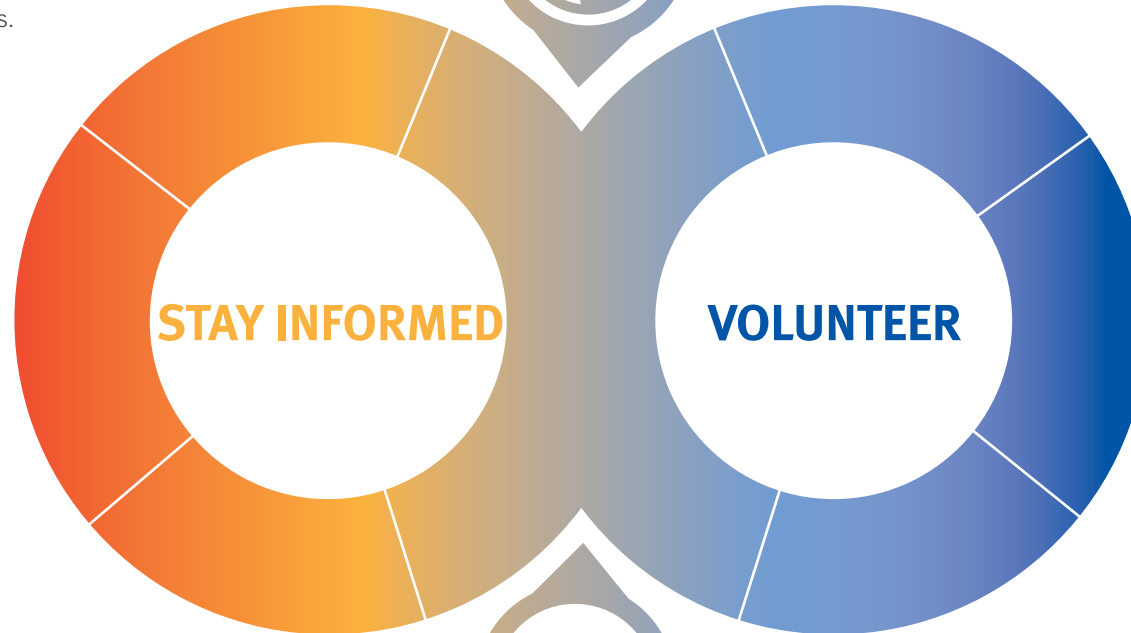
